

# Mien & Family News --- from C. W. Callaway, March 2010

On this page I am highlighting 3 vital Mien ministries dear to my heart.  
Please join us in prayer for each of these projects.

## Recording Whole Mien Bible -- A Huge Project

About 15 to 20 years ago several Mien and I worked about 6 months on recording the Mien New Testament. Since then the Old Testament has also been translated and the New Testament revised. Also we now have more who can read the language and some are good readers. Thus our Mien Christian Mission Fellowship (MCMF) voted recently to undertake the recording of the whole Bible. A committee of 4 was appointed to supervise this project. I am serving as an advisor.

When complete our goal is to make this available on the World wide web, disks, cassettes, and radio so that it can be heard by Mien throughout SE Asia as well as in France, Canada, USA.



Kao Meng Saetern is chair of this committee & also 1 of 5 radio programmers.

Currently only about 1% of Mien worldwide are Christians and only a small

percentage of those are literate. When the Bible is available in audio format then many thousands will be amazed and say as did those Jews long ago, "We hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues." Acts 2:12

## RADIO ANNIVERSARY

In 1993 Liew Chan committed herself to God for radio ministry and began training. The first Mien Christian broadcast was on March 5, 1995 **so a few days ago was the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary!**

Now she and 4 others prepare the programs. Liew writes, "I am very grateful that God has allowed me to have a part in His amazing work in the radio during the past seventeen years. The Mien Radio work is always exciting and challenging... Pray that we are faithful to serve Him with all our heart, so we can focus on Him and be able to reach the Mien People better."

## CRITICAL NEEDS AT CYDC

Over 40 years ago we and co-workers opened a dormitory for tribal students who did not have adequate schools in or near their mountain villages. That first year we had 4 students - 1 Mien and 3 Hmong. For many years parents provided rice, tuition at Chiangkham schools, and spending money. Thus minimal mission funds were used for simple housing and house parents salaries.

From the beginning we and co-workers led Bible studies 2 afternoons a week after school hours and students worked 2 afternoons a week to keep grounds clean and to grow gardens. Week-ends we required them to go back to their home villages so they could keep in contact with their parents and home cultures. Most students then as now are from non-Christian homes but the majority became Christians while staying in the dorms. Often parents and other relatives have also come to Jesus.

Since 1993 these 2 dorms (boys & girls) have borne the name **CYDC (Chiangkham Youth Development Center)**

The current situation is drastically different from the early years. The AIDs epidemic has ravaged many people and numerous parents have been killed or jailed due to drug violence. Many in the dorms would be at risk of prostitution, slavery, or drug trafficking were it not for this safe haven. Most now have no home or family support.

It has become necessary to obtain funds from abroad to care for the needs of these students. The house parents have often used from their own salaries to carry on this ministry. Now the dorm has about \$7,000 shortfall.

In order to maintain this ministry there is an ongoing need for increased financial support. Since many former students now serve as pastors and leaders in churches it has and is serving as a worthy evangelistic tool. Now there are 50 + kids –Mien & Hmong.
