



## A LIVELY LIVING OUT LOUD (LOL) BUNCH AT MIEN YOUTH CAMP

**The 22<sup>nd</sup> annual MCYA youth camp was held July 13-17 in northern California. The full camp theme was "Living Out Loud for Christ" and that theme was well carried out in messages, skits, songs, and action. Main scripture was "... I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, ... For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline" 2 Tim. 1:6-7**

Dearest brothers and sisters,

The harvest was plenty and the workers were provided at the Mien Youth Camp, 2010! First of all, the good news: 11 young people decided to believe in Christ as their personal savior. An amazing 30 decided to be baptized at camp this year! We have not had that number for a long time. 27 campers who have been away from their walk have rededicated their lives to come back again. In total, there were 51 decisions that were made here at camp. Now, we must understand there were only 200 registered at camp. Out of 200, about 40-50 were

staffs and counselors. So about 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the campers have made decisions, big or small at camp. I don't know about you, but that is a very successful camp. The rest of the stats can be found at <http://www.mcya.net>

None of us deserve the credit for what has happened because it was all accomplished by the works of the Holy Spirit for God's glory alone. I do want to thank all those who were willing to be used in this opportunity to serve either with their labor at camp or their prayers at home. I was very pleased to see so many new young Mien leaders rising up to the challenge. This was the year where we had more than 70% of the counselor team being Mien! We have always been struggling to get our young Mien leaders to serve their own and God has truly answered our prayers.

We pray that these leaders will continue their journey and walk with the Lord in the many days and years ahead. Surely we are having a good start right now in this critical transition period of the Mien churches from 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> generation. I urge both young and old to please seriously consider and tackle this transitional challenge that is facing the Mien churches. We do not have any more time to spare! For those
