It is good to know that there is an increasing witness from various countries among Mien & Kim Mun in China.

In mid January I had a good profitable visit from Dr Mana & Kanika Karunawong. I knew her as Jingv. She and 2 sisters were Chinese living in Rom Yen village who came to Christ in the 1950s. She went to Chinese Bible college, married Pastor Mana. I visited them in Taiwan in 2000 when they were missionaries to Thai workmen there. They now serve Thai and Chinese in Thailand. But she remembers her Mien and will be helping Mien friends to provide data for the Mien history.

On Jan. 28th I enjoyed the informative celebration of Mien New Year at Mien Friendship church in Richmond, CA. There were Mien games & skits, explanation & singing of traditional Mien songs, and a traditional Mien orchestra. Dr. Youd Sinh recited his composition of a Mien rhyme (waac-puix) about God blessing us with such celebrations. Also Mien youth sang a contemporary rap in Mien of the Mien alphabet. It was a good Christ-honoring day. My daughter Joyce visited me for 10 days end of Feb. We worked steadily on finalizing Lois' series on prayer. We want to thank all who prayed for her daughter Tina during her brain surgery. Tina recently had a broken ankle but is recovering from that as well as from the surgery and follow-up treatment. Thank you also for prayers for my youngest son David & wife Cathy.

Heaven's angels must have been singing on March 26th as 22 Mien believers were baptized at Portland, OR Fellowship Church. I had attended and preached at the dedication of their new sanctuary last June. "My Timothy" from the Chiang Kham youth dorm Pastor Prasarn Saelee (Yauz-Fuqv) is now serving there after many years with the Seattle Church.
